When Artemest opened its Manhattan flagship, a whimsical installation of vibrant mosaic mirrors by Bradley Theodore was carried across the Atlantic from its initial presentation at the Salone del Mobile. Artemest, the one-stop online shop for all things Italian design, presents a sprawling exhibition of varied marble works at its New York City Galleria space. Dubbed "Marmo," the show tasks myriad Italian artisans with reimagining and rethinking the rigid, jewel-like material—one that has a long history tied to the rolling hills of Italy. Highlights include a chair from UpGroup, which stacks a rainbow of marble hues together, as well as a jaw-dropping, fanlike screen by ELLE DECOR A-Lister Hannes Peer. Homewares abound, too, including a series of vases and trays by Manuel Coltri that deftly render marble in an interlaced patchwork pattern; green stone vessels by Paolo Ulian offer a more pared-back take on the versatile material.
